William Peglow was born in Saint Paul, Minnesota, on January 1, 1864. He was one of a family of twelve children. He grew to manhood in Saint Paul and moved to Sauk Centre in 1890.

Mr. Peglow was a cigar maker by trade and upon his arrival in Sauk Centre he went into partnership with Albert Mansell. They operated this factory jointly for a few years after which Mr. Peglow bought out his partner's interest and conducted the business independently. In 1911, he operated a cigar making business in rooms above the building on the corner of Third and Oak Streets. He carried on at that place until two years before his death.

On August 29, 1911, he married Anna Miller in Sauk Centre. Anna is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Miller, Sr. Fred and Anna (Miller) Peglow had two children: Albert and Warren.

Fred Peglow was an honorary member of the Sauk Centre Fire Department, receiving this position three years before his death.

Mr. and Mrs. Peglow both attended the Saint Paul's Catholic Church. Mr. Peglow died on December 29, 1927, after an illness of two years. He was buried in the Bohemian Cemetery.

Mrs. Peglow still lives in the family home on Oak Street.
