PETERSON, MAGNUS

Magnus Peterson was born July 6, 1874, in Sweden. Magnus obtained a good education and learned the trade of a paving cutter in his native land.

Magnus was married July 1, 1897, to Jennie Dahlboom, who was born July 26, 1876.

In 1902 Magnus came to America. He landed at New York, and went to Millstone Point, Conn., where he secured employment at his trade as paving cutter.

In 1904, Magnus come to St. Cloud, and was employed by Holes Bros. Granite Company. Magnus was then joined by his wife who also came to America.

Magnus and Jennie(Dahlboom) Peterson were the parents of six children: Tekla, Hannah, Margaret, Ruth, Richard and Geneieve.

Tekla, is married to Frank English of Seattle, Washington.

Hannah, is married to Jack Williams of Fargo, North Dakota.

Margaret, is a teacher in the public school system at St. Paul.

Ruth, lives in St. Cloud.

Richard, also lives in St. Cloud.

Geneieve, lives in Seattle, Washington.
