RANDALL, SAMUEL

Samuel Randall was born on June 27, 1862, in Iowa. He is the son of Miles and Harriet Randall.

Samuel attended the common district schools in Iowa. He came to Minnesota about forty years ago. He came part way by horse team and part way by train. They moved onto a farm.

Mr. Randall was first married on April 5, 1889, at Saint Paul, Nebraska, by Judge Haygard. He married a Miss Shoup, a daughter of John and Irene Shoup. Miss Shoup was born in Wisconsin. She had five brothers and sisters. Their children are Annie May Randall, born in Howard County, Nebraska on July 23, 1890; and Elizabeth Irene, born on January 23, 1892. Mrs. Samuel (Shoup) Randall is now dead.

Samuel Randall married Mary Stewart, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Stewart, on December 9, 1909 in Sauk Centre by Judge Charles Morse. The Stewarts had settled on the farm known as Stewart's Bridge, about five miles southeast of Sauk Centre in 1859. There were nine boys and three girls in the Stewart family. Mary (Stewart) Randall was born in Mineral Point, Wisconsin, on October 5, 1851, where she lived until her parents came to Minnesota in 1859. Mary (Stewart) Randall married Isaac Wicks in Sauk Centre when she was a young woman. He died in 1907. There were no children with either marriage. Mary (Stewart) Randall died on January 10, 1933.

Samuel Randall was again married on September 3, 1936 at Sauk Centre by Reverend E. W. Munson, Pastor of the Methodist Church, to Mrs. Lizzie E. (Mills) Underwood.

Mr. Randall was a member of the Methodist Church.

On the Fourth of July the celebration included speeches and a roast pig.

Mr. and Mrs. Randall now live at Hobaken, a section of Sauk Centre.
