SCHEIBEL, FRANK JOSEPH

Frank Joseph Scheibel has been a resident of St. Cloud, Minnesota for over fifty years, he was born January 15, 1884 in St. Wendel Township, Stearns County. His parents were Joseph Scheibel and Thresia (Pendel) Scheibel.

His father, Joseph Scheibel was of Bavarian nativity while his mother was born in St. Cloud, Minnesota a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Pendel. Mr. Pendel being the owner of one of the first hotels in St. Cloud located on Eleventh Avenue and St. Germain St. St. Cloud.

Frank J. Scheibel was raised on the farm of his father and attended the country school of District No. Eleven - St. Wendell Township until the age of thirteen. His teachers were Miss Sophie Krantz and Caroline Waltz of St. Joseph, Minnesota. After school he worked for his father on the farm until he was twenty-one, then he went to Madison, Wisconsin. There he worked as Street Car Motor Man for three years and one year in the Lubricator Factory, of Mason and Kipp. Returning to St. Cloud Mr. Scheibel moved on to a farm near the city, and operated this farm for three years. Later he sold out, and was employed by the Northern States Power Company at the gas plant. This position Mr. Schiebel held for over four years. He was employed by the city, on the St. Cloud Fire Department, where he was fireman for twenty-two years. In 1935 he started to operate the Conoco Oil Station on Seventh Avenue and Second St. South, which he operates at the present time.

Mr. Frank Joseph Scheibel was married on June 15, 1911 to Fanny Pallow of Madison, Wisconsin. To Frank J. and Fanny (Pallow) Scheibel was born one daughter, Mrs. Violet (Scheibel) Allen of Little Falls, Minnesota. Two grand children Joan Allen and William Allen are also of Little Falls.

Mr. Frank Scheibel belongs to St. Mary's Catholic Church, the Firemens Relief Association, and the Fraternal Order of Eagles #622 of St. Cloud, Minnesota.

Mr. Scheibel started work in the St. Cloud Fire Department at a salary of \$50 for two years and the next year the city ran short of funds so the Firemen had to take script for their wages until the following year more money was available, then they were raised to \$60 per month for a period of five years. At this time the liquor license was raised from \$500 to \$1000 a year, this gave the city more money in the treasury, and the salary of the St. Cloud Firemen was raised each year until at the present time the Firemen's salary is \$140 per month.

Mr. Scheibel recalls that the prevailing wage for farm work about 1909 was from fifty cents to a dollar per day with board and room and washing included for ten hours a day.
