SCHLAGHECK, JOHN J.

John J. Schlagheck was born in Ohio February 9, 1862, the son of Henry and Mary (Meyer) Schlagheck. Henry was born in Germany and Mary (Meyer) Schlagheck was born in Ohio.

In 1864 John's parents came to Saint Augusta, Stearns County, Minnesota, and settled on a farm. There were six children in the family. John attended the country school, district 34, where he had Henry Krebs for a teacher.

In 1887 John J. Schlagheck, in partnership with Frank Hurley, opened a brick-yard in Saint Augusta, two years later Henry Beumer bought Frank Hurley's interest.

On November 10, 1891 John married Mary Beumer, Father Paulinus performed the ceremony they celebrated a big wedding with Minne Schlagheck and Henry Buemer as attendents.

Mary Beumer was the daughter of Fredrick and Gesina (Eilers) Beumer, born in Saint Augusta, January 10, 1875.

Fredrick Beumer, the father of Mary, was born February 27, 1841 and came with his parents, Henry C. and Louise (Rotman) Beumer, from Germany in 1857. The family settled on a farm in Saint Augusta.

In 1864 Fredrick enlisted in the Union Army and saw Civil War Service in Nashville, Tennessee. When he returned he continued to farm on the homestead. He was an active church member and helped erect the Saint Augusta Church.

Fredrick Beumer took care of the farms during the Indian uprising in 1862, while the neighboring farmers took their families to the Holes Fort in Saint Cloud. He stayed on his farm, took care of all cattle and horses, and in general managed to get along very well with the Indians and at the same time care for all the farms.

Fredrick Beumer married Gesian Eilers in May 1866. To them were born C. H. Beumer; John; Katherine; Anna; Mary; Louise; Fred; Theresa; and Moritz.

To John and Mary (Beumer) Schlagheck five children were born, Albert, born in 1893, married Mary Mayer they have eight children, Albert is employed at the Peerman Transfer Company Saint Cloud. Fred born in 1896, is deceased. Theresa, born in 1902, married Giddious Tonins, she died in 1924. Martha, born in 1905, died in 1924, and Marceedes, born in 1910, died in 1932.

John J. Schlagheck operated a store in Saint Augusta for eight years. He started with groceries and later branched out to general merchandise. He also had an ice house near Lake George, Saint Cloud, for a period of two years, after which he returned to Saint Augusta township where he farmed until 1914. In that year he moved to the village of Saint Augusta.

John J. Schlagheck died in 1931. He was buried in the family lot at Saint Augusta.
