SCHNEIDER, JOSEPH H.

Joseph H. Schneider was born in Germany. As a youth he attended the public schools and served one term of enlistment in the German Army.

When he was about twenty-two years old Joseph was married to Carolina (Maiden name unknown). To Joseph H. and Carolina Schneider were born seven children. Frank, Mary, John, Kate, Pauline, Jake, and Joseph.

About 1891 his wife, Carolina Schneider, passed away. In 1894 Joseph brought his family to the United States. They settled on a farm near Des Moines, Iowa. About 1897 Joseph moved his family to St. Joseph, Minnesota, where he purchased a farm. This farm was successfully operated by him until his death about 1919. Of the seven children five are living.

Frank is married and lives in North Dakota. Mary is married to John Studer, they live in Iowa. Pauline is the wife of Matt Koch of St. Cloud. Jake is a farmer in Saint Joseph. Joseph and Kate are dead. John is married and lives in Montana.
