SCHULER, ANDREW

Andrew Schuler was born in Bruce County, Ontario, Canada. He was a son of Joseph Henry, and Margaret (Kuennehan) Schuler, who were natives of the old country. The parents came to Canada, and settled in Bruce County, where Joseph Henry followed the carpenter trade for a number of years, and then later started to farm.

In 1889 the Schuler family moved to Bruce County, North Dakota, and operated a farm for the rest of their natural life. The father, Joseph Henry Schuler, died in 1917, and the mother, Margaret (Kuennehan) Schuler, died in 1920. Both parents were buried at Mount Carmel, Cavalier County, North Dakota.

Andrew Schuler attended the rural school in Ontario until he was about fifteen years old, and then learned the carpenter trade, and later farmed for a few years. In 1916 he went to Detroit, Michigan, and in a short time he returned to St. Cloud, where he worked for the Pan Motor Company, following the machinist and carpenter trade. In 1922 Andrew was employed by the Great Northern Railway Company at Waite Park as a carpenter, and at the present time is still in their employ.

Andrew Schuler was married June 22, 1909 in Berlin Ontario, Canada, to Louisa Feil, who was a daughter of Henry and Louisa (Schierman) Feil of Waterloo Ontario, a pioneer carpenter contractor.

To Andrew and Louisa (Feil) Schuler were born seven children, five of which are living. Andrew Henry, was born in North Dakota March 28, 1910, and died at the age of eleven years, on August 26, 1921. Louisa, was born in North Dakota, on March 7, 1911, and now is Mrs. Martin L. Weller of Cincinnati, Ohio. George Henry, was born in North Dakota on July 2nd, 1912

and lives in St. Cloud, he is employed by the Atlantic and Pacific Stores Incorporated. August Joseph, was born in North Dakota on July 24, 1914, and lives at Cincinnati, Ohio. Edward Joseph, was born in Detroit, Michigan, on October 28, 1916 and lives in St. Cloud, he is employed at the National Tea Company. Albert J. was born in St. Cloud, March 14, 1921, and lives at home. Anna Catherine, was born in St. Cloud, June 1st, 1924, she died in infancy.

Andrew and Louisa (Feil) Schuler are making their home at 217 Twelfth Avenue North, St. Cloud, Minnesota.
