SCHWAB, PHILLIP

Phillip Schwab was born in Germany in 1830. He received his schooling in his native country and also received his pharmaceutical training there. He came to America and settled in New Orleans in 1855. Due to a plague of yellow fever a few years later he left and came to Minnesota.

He settled at Rockford and served in the Civil War during 1863 and 1864. After returning from service he moved to Monticello and then to Clearwater, Minnesota, where he was engaged in the Drug Business. He added items of the mercantile trade to his business.

He married Hattie Heberling, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David Herberling, in 1869. Miss Herberling was born in Pennsylvania in 1848. Her parents came to Minnesota when she was still an infant and she attended school in Clearwater and Wright County.

About 1888 Carl D. and Hattie (Heberling) Schwab moved to Clear Lake and established a general store. Mr. Schwab died in November 1889, but his sons helped to carry on the business. In 1910 Mrs. Schwab came to Saint Cloud with her son, Carl, and still resides with him at 402-Fourth Avenue South.

Five children were born to her, three boys and two girls: Lizzie W.; Carl D.; Edward P.; Will J.; and Hattie.
