SEABURY, WILLIAM L.

William L. Seabury was born August 5, 1864 at Plymouth, Ohio, the son of Stephen and Mary (Tuttle) Seabury.

In 1867 the parents moved to Winnabago Prairie, Wisconsin, where they homesteaded.

William received his education at the district school which he attended seven years.

In 1884 William went to Charles City, Iowa, where he was employed in a foundry.

He was married to Gertrude O'Hair in 1888.

William continued his residence in Charles City, Iowa until 1908 when he moved to Saint Cloud, Minnesota, then entering the employ of the Jone's Granite Company, where he was employed until 1935.

William and Gertrude (O'Hair) Seabury were the parents of three children. Fred, born July 17, 1890, now lives in Chicago, Illinois. Belma, born October 19, 1893, married Charles Marvin of Marshfield, Wisconsin. LeRoy, born April 14, 1901, married and lives in St. Cloud.
