SIEGLER, MIKE

Mike Siegler was born at Coblenz, Germany on October 19, 1862. The childhood and early youth of the subject of this sketch were spent in the vicinity of his birth, where he received what was at that time regarded as a liberal education. At the age of twenty years he came to America.

His first two years in America were spent in Philadelphia, where he was employed in a hotel. He came to Saint Cloud in 1883. He was then employed by Nicholas Brauch in a hotel on what is now Seventh Avenue North and First Street, shortly after Mike left Mr. Brauch's employ, and accepted a position with the Great Northern Railway on the section. In 1911 Mike was retired by the Great Northern Railroad on a pension, after twenty-five years in their employ without missing a day's work.

On March 10, 1900 Mike was married to Mary Thies of Cold Spring, Minnesota, daughter of Peter and Anna Theis.

Mike and Mary (Theis) Siegler were the parents of one child, Mike H. Siegler, who now makes his home with his parents in Saint Cloud.
