STAUB, CLEMENS, R. C.

Clemens Staub, R. C. priest, born in Baar, Switzerland, August 10, 1819; died at St. Joseph, Minnesota, in 1886. He came to the United States in 1849; was ordained priest in 1852; came to Minnesota in 1857, being the first missionary to hold services in many places in Stearns county; had charge of Assumption Church, St. Paul thirteen years, afterward was pastor of the church at St. Joseph, Stearns County.
