STROUT, S. C.

S. C. Strout was born in Maine in 1833, and went to Wisconsin in 1855 and engaged in farming. In 1865 he moved to Maine Prairie, and in 1867 he settled in Fair Haven, where he operated a farm until 1874, when he engaged in the mercantile business for two years, and kept a hotel one year. He moved to Monticello, where he remained until 1887. He and his son, Fred L., then engaged in the mercantile business in Fair Haven until his death in 1893. His son, Fred L., sold out the store and moved to Paynesville.

Silas C. Strout, born in Maine, April 22, 1831; came to Minnesota in 1865; settled in Fairhaven, Stearns County, in 1868, where he engaged in mercantile business and kept a hotel.
