Oscar Taylor, lawyer, born in Lisbon, New Hampshire, February 10, 1832; died in Leavenworth, Kansas, October 17, 1905. He settled in St. Cloud, Minnesota, about 1860; served as captain in the First Minnesota Mounted Rangers, 1862 to 1863, was a representative in the legislature in 1865, was attorney of Stearns County several terms.
