WILEY, T. J.

Among the later arrivals, who were prominent in town affairs, was T. J. Wiley, who was born in Meigs county, Ohio, in 1838. He was brought up on a farm, and in 1857 came to Anoka county with his parents. When of age he engaged in lumbering winters and summers at other work. Mr. Wiley and Miss Orlenda Frost were married in 1862. In 1863, they moved to Maine Prairie and pre-empted a homestead which he improved and carried on in connection with running a steam thresher and sawing lumber winters. In 1880 he moved to Fergus Falls, but returned to St. Cloud in 1887, where he still resides.
