Dear Virginia:

Delighted to hear that you are near us again. I hope that it may be possible for you to come up here before we leave. We are likely to go off a trip in the middle of August but we have no definite plans yet and, even though we were gone, you might enjoy having a few days up here in the coolness, if you can get away – which of course may not be possible.

I don't think your idea for your father and mother to drive from Minnesota to North Carolina and up to New York and then here in August, is a very sensible one, for the reason that it would be a fiendishly hot trip most of the way and hard work rather than fun. Sometime between the middle of September and the middle of October might be a better time but, even so, I think it would be foolish to make the trip anyway down to North Carolina. You better leave that to them.
