The book will be out October 3rd; the Cosmopolitan serial will be on the stands in about a week now. Did I tell you that my heroine is named Virginia – only I spell her familiar name Jinny, not Ginny.

I'm tired after a year of book, with now the proofs and a lot of little accumulated jobs on top – tired but well, and I shall be glad to motor out to Minnesota (I'm allowed gas rations to get my car out there, as I'm Changing residence) and chase around outdoors and forget the very look of typewriter keys.

Micky will be out with me for a few weeks. I hope to go up into Arrowshead with him. I'll spend a week or so in Minneapolis on my way and see all our old friends. No. I have never heard from nor of Faubian since I last saw him in Minneapolis.
